A Brief History of the Chicago Society

The Chicago Society is truly the first Polish American Society in America. On Friday, April 19th, 1912, the Society was formally organized. The name Chicago Society was adopted at this meeting. The twenty-nine charter members had affiliated the unit with the largest Polish fraternal body in North America, the Polish National Alliance. In 1924, the Society created a Ladies Auxiliary, now known as the Polish Women's Civic Club, to assist in the social service work conducted by the Society. In addition, the Society formed the Polish Welfare Association, now known as the Polish American Association, which initially had as its goal to systematize and coordinate the humanitarian work of various Polish charitable units and aided in the care and prevention of delinquency among Polish youth.

Meetings of the Chicago Society

Meetings are held on the 3rd Wednesday of each month throughout the year, offering members an opportunity to network, offer mutual support, and explore new opportunities. The Chicago Society of the Polish National Alliance vigorously stimulates membership and offers its members support in their business, civic and professional efforts. Furthermore, the Chicago Society PNA, welcomes members to participate in wholesome activities and social events provided by the organization. A monthly newsletter, The Forum, and the website keeps the membership informed about activities and organizational news.

The Chicago Society Foundation

The Foundation is a private charitable organization affiliated with, but separate from, the Chicago Society. It is the successor organization to the Chicago Society Building Corporation, which originally held and then sold, the Society's clubhouse because of changing neighborhood and building management circumstances. The new Foundation was created for tax-advantage reasons to permit donors to obtain charitable deductions, and for flexibility in managing philanthropic causes. Its constitution requires it to provide philanthropic and charitable assistance specifically and only to individuals and organizations dedicated to the Polish American community.



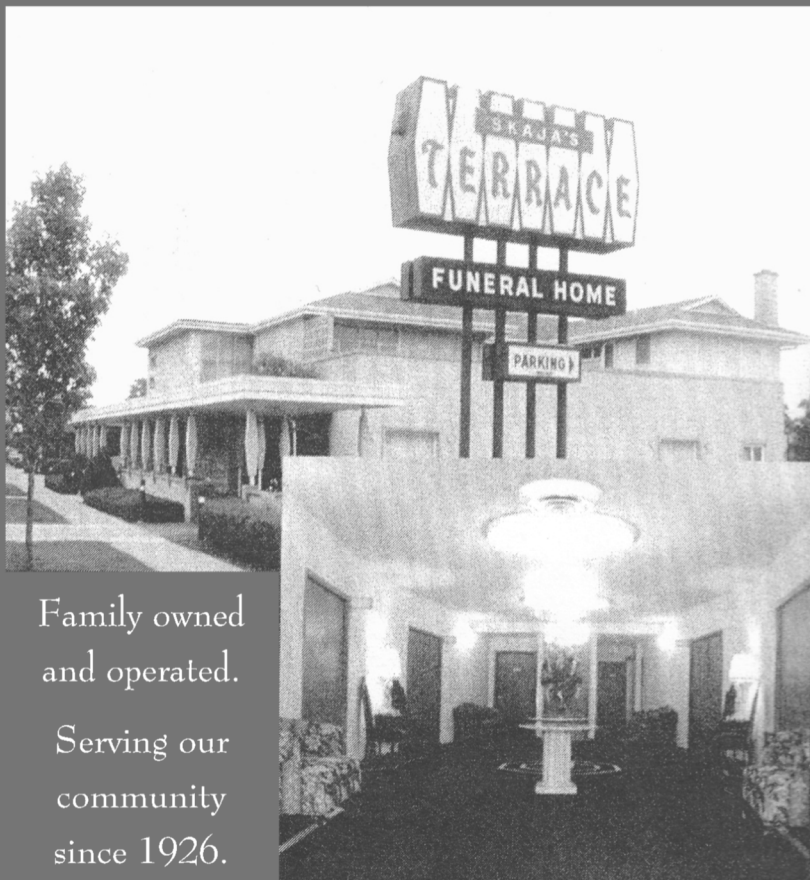

Centrum Polsko-Słowiańskie (CP-S) jest społeczno-kulturalną organizacją nieodpłatową, założoną w 1972 r. z siedzibą w Nowym Jorku, która służy głównie polskiej grupie etnicznej. CPS, największa polsko-amerykańska organizacja na Wschodnim Wybrzeżu, liczy około 40 tys. członków. CP-S służy polskiej i słowiańskiej społeczności, a kiedy zachodzi potrzeba, Centrum dokłada wszelkich sił do obrony praw należnych naszej grupie etnicznej. Pomysłodawcą i założycielem Centrum dla Polonii nowojorskiej był ksiądz Longin Tolezyk, który z niewielką grupą ludzi wprowadził w życie swoje idee. Idea i marzenia urzeczywistniły się, kiedy to w 1972 r. powstało Centrum Polsko-Słowiańskie. W 1977 r. została założona Polsko-Słowiańska Federalna Unia Kredytowa. W ciągu lat Centrum, zarządzane przez kolejne rady dyrektorów, rozwijało swą działalność. Obecnie organizacja posiada dwa budynki na Greenpoincie przy 177 Kent St. i przy 176 Java St. Co roku Centrum otrzymuje od władz miasta dotacje na tworzenie nowych programów, które pozwalają poszerzyć bezpłatnie usługi dla członków CP-S.

Niezwykłe rezultaty działalności Centrum Polsko-Słowiańskiego nie byłyby możliwe bez udziału naszych członków. Należy podkreślić, że każdy z Państwa ma swój udział w tym sukcesie. Bowiem istnienie Centrum zależy głównie od nas samych, naszego wsparcia finansowego, poprzez roczne składki członkowskie, które pomagają realizować następujące programy:

PROGRAM IMIGRACYJNO-PRAWNY

Głównym zadaniem programu jest pomoc nowo przybyłym emigrantom z Polski i krajów Europy Wschodniej w przystosowaniu się do nowych warunków życia. Służy fachową poradą prawną w sprawach imigracyjnych, pomaga w uregulowaniu legalnego pobytu. Przygotowuje do egzaminu na obywatelstwo.

KLUB SENIORA „KRAKUS”

Klub „Krakus” skupia seniorów, którym codziennie przygotowuje 450 obiadów. Działalność klubu obejmuje także zajęcia rekreacyjne i opiekę społeczną. Każdego dnia program dostarcza ludziom chorym i niepełnosprawnym obiady do domu. Klub „Krakus” współpracuje z Klubem Seniora im. Jana Pawła II na Manhattanie.

KLUB SENIORA IM. JANA PAWŁA II

Centrum Polsko-Słowiańskie od 1 września 1996 r. jest oficjalnym sponsorem Klubu Seniora, który mieści się przy kościele św. Stanisława na Manhattanie. Kontrakt zawarty z City Department for the Aging pozwala świadczyć seniorom szersze usługi: dostarczanie obiadów do domu, zajęcia rozrywkowe, wycieczki, lekcje angielskiego, pogadanki na temat żywienia i ochrony środowiska naturalnego.

PROGRAM USŁUG SOCJALNYCH DLA SENIORÓW

Od 25 lat ten program świadczy usługi ludziom starszym o niskich dochodach. Program obejmuje szeroki wachlarz usług socjalnych: od spraw mieszkaniowych, świadczeń zdrowotnych do informowania i wyjaśniania nowych przepisów socjalnych.

PROGRAM AKCJI SPOŁECZNEJ

Głównym zadaniem programu jest pomoc imigrantom w otrzymaniu świadczeń ze strony władz federalnych, stanowych i miejskich. Program organizuje też w razie potrzeby pomoc doraźną i jest skierowany do ludzi, których sytuacja losowa wymaga natychmiastowej pomocy.

KURSY JĘZYKA ANGIELSKIEGO

CP-S oferuje kursy języka angielskiego na różnych poziomach zaawansowania. Zajęcia odbywają się w różnych, dogodnych godzinach.

SEKCJA SZERMIERKI

Z inicjatywy Rady Dyrektorów Centrum Polsko-Słowiańskiego od września 2002 przy 176 Java Street na Greenpoincie, w każdy piątek odbywają się zajęcia z szermierki dla dzieci i młodzieży. Treningi prowadzone są przez Janusza Młynka, założyciela i twórcę wielu sukcesów Polsko-Amerykańskiej Szkoły Szermierczej oraz głównego trenera sekcji szermierczej w New Jersey Institute of Technology w Newark.

PROGRAM STYPENDIALNY

Od kilku lat Rada Dyrektorów Centrum Polsko-Słowiańskiego oferuje młodej uzdolnionej studiującej młodzieży stypendia.

Ralph Modjeski world renown builder of great American bridges, son of actress Helena Modjeska, was also a virtuoso pianist. He performed with Ignacy Jan Paderewski in Chicago, had a great love for Chopin, played from memory his Nocturnes, Polonaises, Etudes and Mazurkas. He was a member of the Philosophical and Art Societies. He had a reputation as a designer of very safe, economical and esthetically pleasing structures. Modjeski received many of the greatest engineering awards. He was an outstanding businessman and an exceptional organizer of construction sites.

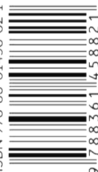
